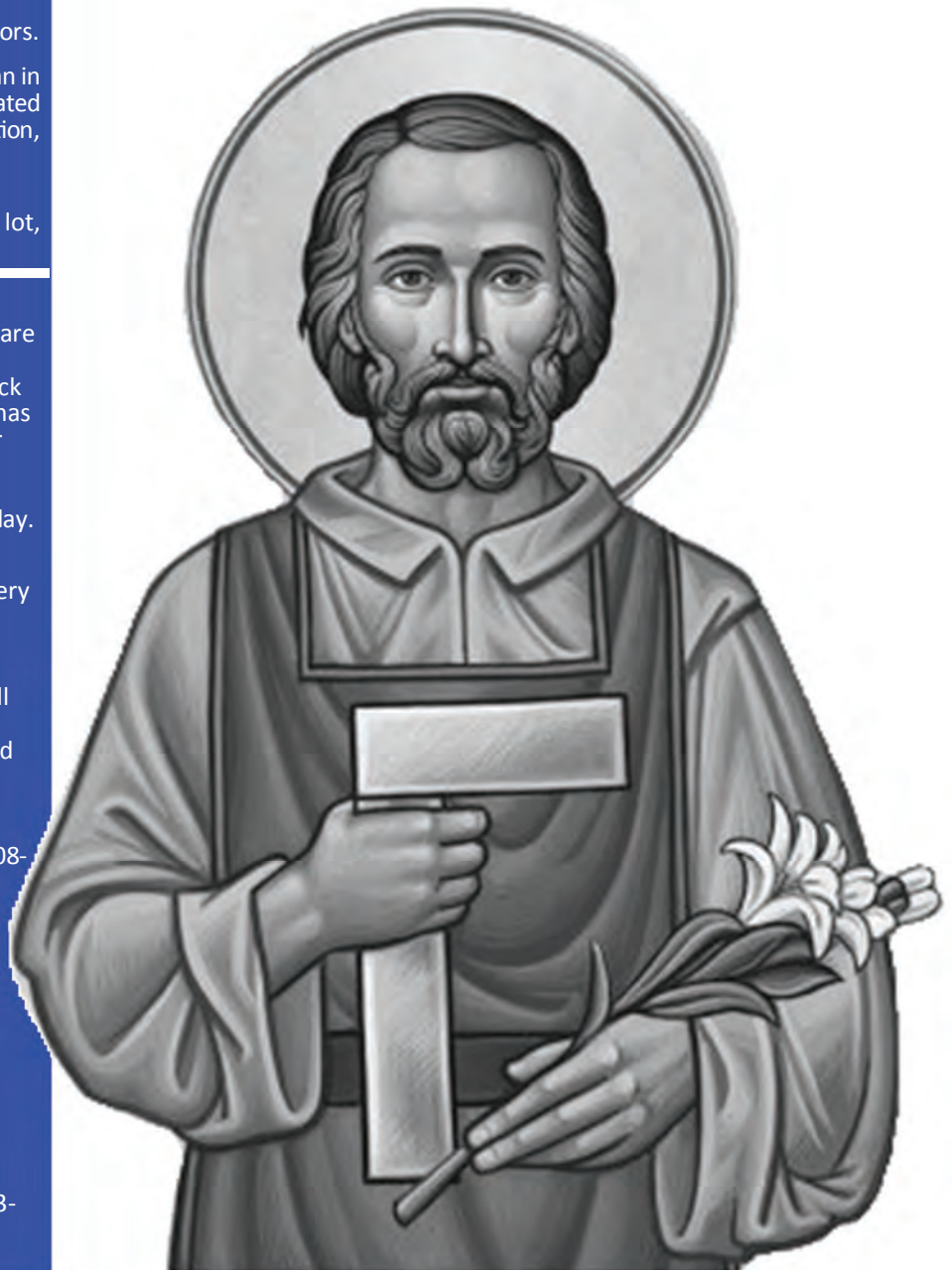

**Pasta Dinner** - Thanks and blessings for all who joined the fun at last week's Pasta Dinner. I want to thank the Knights and all the volunteers for their gallant efforts. Mostly, I want to thank all who attended and made the night terrific. The vibe was tops.

**Some Fun facts:** Total number of meals served, 428; pounds of pasta cooked, 82; number of meatballs made, 940; amount of meat in meatballs, 115 pounds; number of volunteers, 70.

**Fireside Faith: The Mass** – Remember Fireside Psalms? This will be just like that . . . but different. Our sessions will be at 8:00 pm on 5 Wednesday nights, beginning February 21. Copies of the book – Kevin Irwin's *The Mass: 101 Questions and Answers* – will be on sale this weekend in the Gathering Space for \$20.

**The Coat Drive Total Kept Growing** – Even after the initial tally of 673, more coats arrived. The total now stands at 737. Once again, you have outdone yourselves in Christian kindness.

**Eighth Grade CCD – Three Cheers!** – A big shout out to our Monday night, eighth grade CCD Class. With the help of catechists Christine Lewis and Kristen Ross, they delivered a major donation of food to the Community Assistance Network. A big "thank you" to them and the CCD families that made it happen.

**Construction Projects** – Our HVAC firm has confirmed that the new units are on schedule for a mid-April delivery. With luck, the installation will occur in late April. Since the initial bids were submitted, the costs of electric and gas work have increased substantially. We now suspect that project costs will be closer to \$550k than to \$500k. Again, thanks to you, we have the money in the bank to pay for that work. The repainting of the Gathering Space and church interior should take place in May. Stay tuned.

## LENTEN OBLIGATIONS

So that the Church of Metuchen may be spiritually one in a common observance of Lent, the following days of fast and abstinence are to be observed by all Catholics of the Diocese who enjoy the blessings of good health:

1. The days of fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
2. All other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.
3. From the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday until the celebration of the Easter Vigil on the evening of Holy Saturday, the Easter fast should be observed so that, with uplifted and welcoming hearts, we may be ready to celebrate the joys of the Resurrection. This ancient tradition, intimately connected with the Rites of Holy Week and the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, is encouraged, especially in those places baptizing catechumens at the Easter Vigil.

The obligation to fast applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. To fast in the Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal during the day so as to experience hunger.

The obligation of abstinence affects all Catholics who have reached the age of 14. Abstinence in the Catholic tradition means to abstain from meat. The obligation of fast and abstinence, as a whole, is a serious obligation. While failure to observe any penitential day in itself may not be considered serious, the failure to observe any penitential days at all, or a substantial number of them without good cause, would be considered a grave matter. Those unable to abstain for a valid reason on any given Friday of Lent are asked to perform some other penitential act, or to abstain on another day.

## WORD OF THE WEEK

### Fasting \ˈfa-stɪŋ\

Refraining from food and drink for religious purposes. Biblically, it implied not eating or drinking from morning till evening.

The Catholic Church defines **fasting** as one full meal a day, with two additional breaks. Catholics observe a eucharistic **fast** and abstain from food and drink one hour prior to receiving Holy Communion. They also **fast** annually on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday if in good health and between the ages of 21 and 59.

### WHY IT MATTERS

When we're self-sufficient, it's easy to forget that God is our ultimate source of life and hope. **Fasting** is a visceral reminder to trust in God. **Fasting** helps us to detach from worldly things not because they are bad but to remind us that God is the source of all gifts.

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church: "**Fasting** and abstinence . . . help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart" (2043).

## QUESTION OF THE WEEK

### Why do we fast?

Why **fast**? Our survival requires us to eat and drink. When we refrain from these most basic activities, it reminds us that "we do not live by bread alone." **Fasting** provides us with an opportunity to affirm our faith in God's providential care.

**Fasting** as a spiritual practice falls into the category of sacrifice. As in other acts of religious sacrifice, **fasting** takes something away from us. **Fasting** stirs us to contemplate justice—many in this world go without food—and motivates us to pray in a deeper, richer way. Because we don't want to do it, **fasting** is regarded as a penitential practice: We do it in reparation for sin, ours and the world's.

When you think of everything **fasting** can do—encourage fidelity and humility, awaken the spirit of justice, enhance prayer, assist those who are tempted—the question becomes: Why *not fast*?

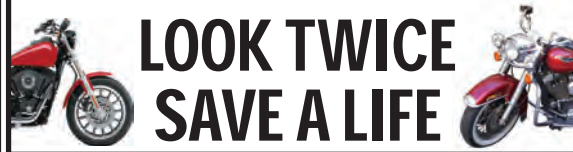

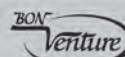
