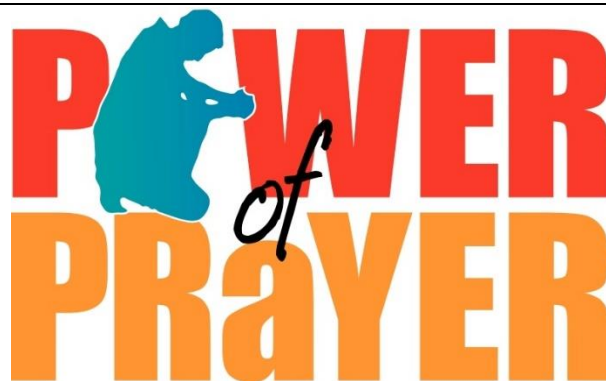

THIS MOMENT IN PRAYER

OUR NEW CARILLON – Thanks again to the Viola family and to all who contributed to the carillon given in Frank Viola's honor. Its chimes and hymns are a beautiful addition to our parish and our neighborhood.

SUNDAY MASSES – I ask everyone to say a prayer, and perhaps perform some small act of kindness, for the cause of our limited return to having people in church. Please ask God to bless the process and to keep everyone safe. To minimize the chances of contracting the virus from surfaces in the church, we have had the entire church deep cleaned, disinfected and protected with an antiviral film. We will also fog the church after every use. To minimize the chances of anyone contracting the virus from anyone at church, thank you for honoring the following guidelines if you are physically coming to Mass:

Wear your mask whenever you are on church grounds and not in your vehicle.

Maintain Social Distance at all times.

Proceed from your car to one of the three tents to check-in, sanitize your hands, and have your temperature taken.

Sit where the usher instructs you to sit.

Remain in your seat until after Mass, when an usher will direct you to a Communion station.

Proceed directly from Communion to your car, then pray and depart.


