## This Moment in Prayer, Service and Community

Dear All: Christ's peace!

Saint Pope Pius X (1835-1914), changed the way we go to Communion. Before him, weekly Communion was unusual and daily Communion almost unheard of, except in monasteries and convents. #### This Moment in Prayer


