

This Moment in Prayer, Service and Community

Dear All:

Christ's Peace. Think of this as the special Pandemic, Pre-Christmas edition of my weekly letter. We have lots going on for Advent and Christmas. The more you know, the better off you are.

O Holy Nights

This Sunday - Our Live Nativity - The final installment of "O Holy Nights" will be one fine evening. Each car will be guided down Yorktown Road to the entrance point. Near the door to the parish hall, parish elves will check your registration time (see below), provide Saint Jo-coa for each passenger, give you a copy of "I Heard God Laugh" (this year's parish book) if you have not already received one, and some fun stickers for any kids in the car. You will then proceed down the line of lighted trees and JUST before the woods, turn right into the recently plowed fire road behind the church. Driving down the road, you will encounter live re-enactments (staged by humans from our Youth Ministry and animals from local herds) of the Annunciation, the Journey to Bethlehem, the Shepherds in the Field, and the Nativity. As you pass the north side of the Parish Hall, you will catch glimpses of Bethlehem projected onto a big screen. All the while, your FM radio station (88.7) will be playing Nativity scripture passages (read by members of our Youth

Group) and Christmas music. You will be very glad you experienced it.

This Sunday – Registration— We have had to shuffle things around a bit. Some had already registered for the event. Since the early registrations, changes in government guidelines have encouraged us to change the registration process. We will admit cars in batches. The batches will enter at 15-minute intervals. Please go to https://www.stjosephsparish.com/o-holy-nights-advent-2020 to register. Those of you who had registered for the original 4:30 and 6:30 sessions have already received notice of your new times. Thanks for your help with this.

Last Sunday – Tailgate Caroling – Greatest thanks to all who made the night so excellent. Thanks to Matt Viola, Randa Rydzy and all the choir members who led us in song. Thanks to all the food truck folks who delivered the Saint Jo-coa to the cars. Thanks to the ushers who did a bangup job. And greatest thanks to all the participants who made it a night to remember. Superabundant thanks to those who decorated their cars, set up tailgate situations, and poured great amounts of merriment into the night. Clearly, tailgate caroling is now a thing. A completely marvelous thing.

Christmas Masses

REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED FOR EVERY CHRISTMAS MASS:

Pre-Christmas Christmas Masses – Understandably, all the Masses on Christmas Eve, as well as the 9:30 Mass on Christmas morning were fully subscribed very quickly. (NB – Please pardon the phrase "sold out" on the registration page. Many of us find it both bothersome and inaccurate. Regrettably, the phrase is baked into the software.) Anticipating this, we have scheduled Pre-Christmas Christmas Masses for this coming week. While the 8:35 am Masses will be the Masses for the day, there will also be a 7:00 pm Mass that will use the readings and prayers for Christmas. I strongly encourage you to come to one of those evening Masses if you have been boxed out of the others. Regardless of the day, it helps to hear the story. Above all, it helps to receive the Body of Christ whose Incarnation we celebrate. Your pandemic flexibility can make the pre-Christmas Christmas Mass the center of a most beautiful evenina.

Christmas Mass Precaution Levels – We are trying to accommodate every level of concern about the virus. We trust that everyone will have a chance to hear the Word and receive the Eucharist in a setting that matches their level of precaution.

Extraordinary Precautions – The parking lot Masses (2:00 pm Christmas Eve and 11:30 am Christmas Day) are the absolute safest Masses. You never come close to other people and have only momentary exposure to the Eucharistic Minister who visits your car.

Extra Precautions – the Tuesday evening 7:00 pm Mass and the 9:30 Mass on Christmas morning are Seraphim Masses with extra precautions. Please expect the following practices – which are implemented for the well-being of all, especially the most vulnerable, who are deeply consoled by the knowledge that potentially dangerous interactions are minimized:

Masks and social distancing are required from the moment you leave your car.

Your temperature will be taken when you enter the church.

You need to sit where the ushers direct you, at the time they direct you.

You need to stay in your seat the whole time. If you need to get up, you will have to wait outside the church.

Standard Precautions – The 5:00 pm and 8:00 pm Masses on Christmas eve will be Cherubim Masses with standard precautions. Masks and social distancing are required from the moment you exit your car.

Christmas Collections – My sincere thanks to those who have asked for guidance for giving to the Christmas collections. We rely on the Christmas collection for nearly 10% of our yearly income and we rely on it to pay all our insurance bills at year's end. You have four basic options for contributing.

Online Giving – If you are an online giver, you need to instruct your account to make a Christmas contribution, in addition to whatever you have instructed it to do for weekly contributions. By next Tuesday, we will have instructions posted on the parish web page for those who are contributing to the Christmas collection online for the first time.

Parking Lot Giving – It seems slightly rough, but I haven't heard anything better. For those of you participating in the parking lot Masses, there will be a big (carefully guarded!) barrel at the check in. Please use it to deposit your envelope or other gift.

Collection Baskets in Church – If you are participating in one of the in-church Masses, there will be baskets located in the Gathering Space on your way out.

Office Visit or Mail – if none of the above works for you, you can always mail your Christmas envelope, put it in the black mailbox by the Parish Hall door, or bring it to the office. GREAT thanks for supporting the church when it is not so easy to do.

There is so much going on at church these days – in prayer, service, and community-building – but I wanted to share the above today – and leave much of the other good news for next week or beyond.

One more thing – your contribution letters. Each year, we send you a letter, for your tax reports and other records, about how much you have contributed in the calendar year. To keep it simpler for you and for our office, we are happy to email those letters. If you would like to receive yours by email, please email your name, address and envelope number to mmcdevitt@stjosephsparish.com Please send that email from the email account to which you want your contribution letter sent.

With great thanks, all best blessings, and great confidence that our pandemic Christmas will be outstanding – oh so different and oh so excellent as we recall, in a most profound way, that the light shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it – never has, never will. Amen.




