

LIFE-GIIVING WOUNDS VIRTUAL RETREAT

The Diocese of Metuchen's Office of Family Life will sponsor this retreat, designed for anyone over the age of 18 whose parents are no longer together. The virtual retreat will be conducted over the course of **3 Saturdays: April 17& 24 & May 1**. On the first 2 Saturdays, participants will attend via Zoom from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and on the 3rd Saturday, a Mass will be celebrated for all adult children of divorce.

People of all backgrounds attend, but together they have one key thing in common: they have lost the love of their parents together.
